

## Graduate Courses CE Grid Updated 02/09/2012

**PLEASE BE ADVISED: State CE laws change continually and approved course renewals vary. Either situation may cause a change in the number or breakdown of credits listed after publication. The student is ultimately responsible for making sure that credits are correct and reported.**

### Financial Planners
